City Leaders have asked Capitol Hill Village to recruit individuals who would be willing to provide rides to seniors to doctors' appointments, to get groceries and to purchase new clothes and personal items.

We are in the process of coordinating with community partners and the residents, but we are expecting to have shifts of drivers, so you would sign up for a time and take any residents that need a ride. There are also opportunities for scheduled rides, such as to the doctor, if you have flexibility in your schedule.

You may volunteer for this effort even if you are not an existing CHV volunteer, or a CHV Volunteer driver.
